Dear EYFS Parents and Carers,

We cannot wait to have the children back in school next week! Following Mr Jarrett's whole school letter, we would just like to add a few reminders, specific to EYFS.

Reading books and home learning

If your child is on a reading book we will resume sending them home on Monday, 15th March, thus giving us a week to assess the children and ensuring they are at the right point of the reading scheme. Book changes will continue to happen on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. If your child has struggled with a book or really enjoyed it please feel free to keep it for an additional day.

You will be pleased to hear that we are giving you a break from Teams and will not be setting any weekly Home Learning tasks for the rest of this term. Home Learning will resume after the Easter break. After Easter we will be sending home a letter about how we would like you to complete the Home Learning for the remainder of EYFS.

Drop off & pick up

Drop off and pick up will be exactly the same as before Christmas.

The children will be coming straight into their classrooms in the morning. Kiss & Drop children begin arriving at 8.40am and everyone else should aim to arrive as close to 8.50am as possible, please. Children will not be allowed into class before this time so please do not arrive too early as you will be asked to wait outside and we want to avoid large crowds due to social distancing.

The EYFS children can be collected at 3:10pm. Please wait on the playground where your child's class teacher can see you, as they will be dismissed from the decking.

Toys/Show & tell

We are keeping to the same toys/show and tell rule as before, please do not allow your child to bring in any toys or show & tell to school. Photos can be emailed to your class teacher instead, with a limit of one per week please.

PE

We will continue to have PE on a Wednesday. Children should arrive to school in suitable PE attire.

Spare clothes

Please ensure your child has a spare set of clothes in school in case of accidents. We recommend supplying these in the Oldfield PE bag which can be kept on their peg. **All clothes should be clearly named.**



Snacks

A general reminder that children need one healthy fruit/vegetable snack for their morning break. No nuts are allowed as snacks, or in their packed lunches.

Medication


If your child has an inhaler or epi-pen please ensure we have one in school for them. We are unable to provide your child with any medication unless you have signed a medical form.
