The demand for places at Royal Borough schools means that the LA must operate admissions rules to ensure the allocation of places is fair, objective and for the benefit of all children.

Choosing a school for one’s child is an important decision. It is often possible to get a feel for a school by visiting during the daytime when the children are in school. School tours run by the Headteacher are available to prospective parents/guardians to see Oldfield in action.
