Reading skills

- **Prediction** - **Predict** what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far.
- **Inference** - Make **inferences** from the text. How and why questions. Using information from the text to answer and justify questions.
- **Vocabulary** - Draw on knowledge of **vocabulary** to understand texts.
- **Sequencing** - Identify and explain the **sequence** of events in texts.
- **Retrieval** - Identify/explain key aspects of fiction and non-fiction texts, such as characters, events, titles and information.

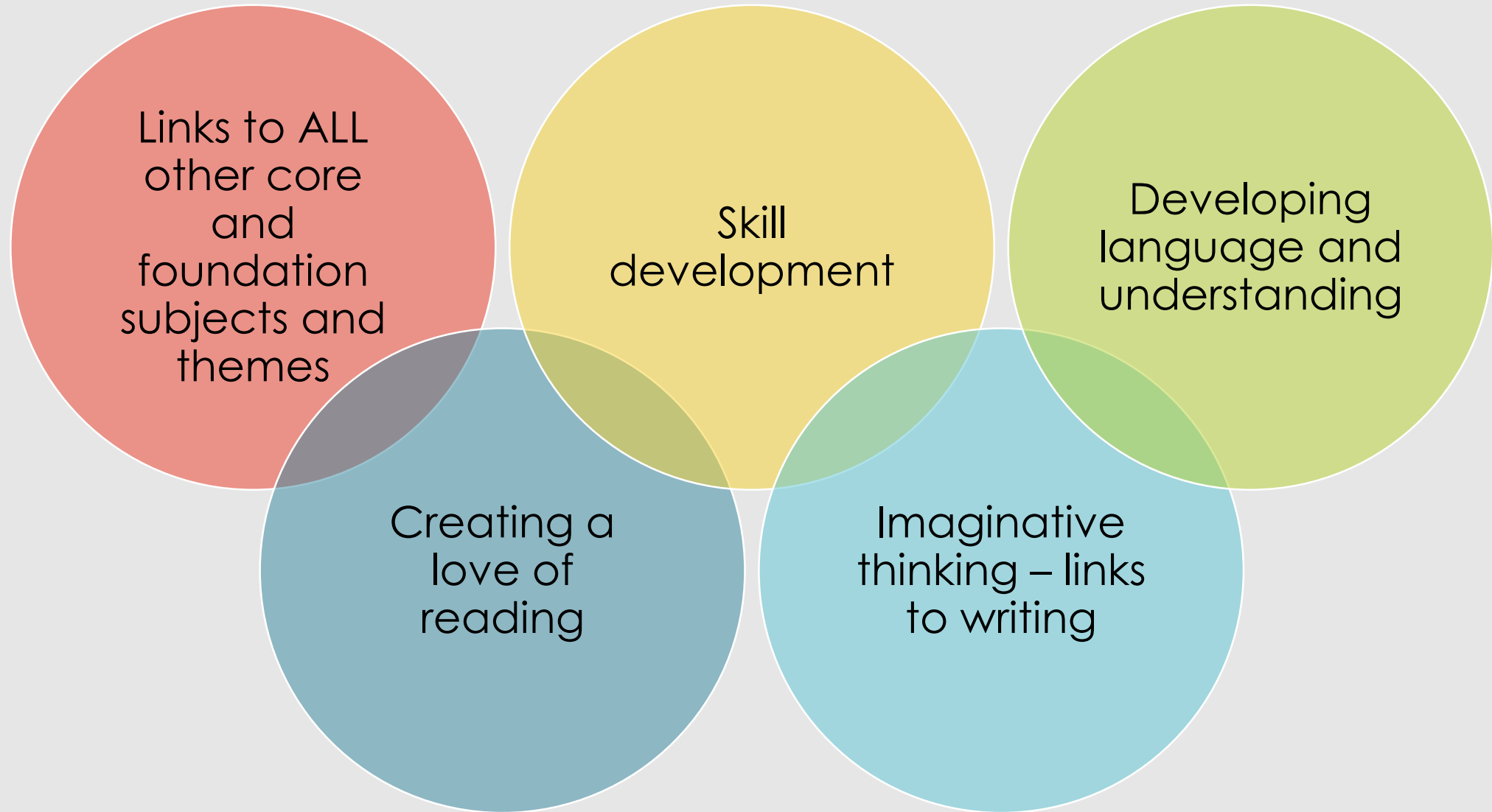
