compare and contrast	Looking for similarities and differences between 2 countries.
continent	A large mass of land which can be made up from individual countries. There are 7 continents: North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia and Antarctica.
country	A smaller piece of land which is within a continent, eg: England or Spain.
currency	The money used in a country.
equator	A line that goes around the centre of the Earth.
globe	A map which is a sphere and is a replica of the world.
temperature	How hot or cold a place is.
