Hello Year 1 Parents and Carers,

We have another action-packed term ahead and are excited for what we have in store for the children. In English, we were be focusing on our key text, The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry and developing the children's understanding of sentence structure, punctuation and how to edit their own work. The children will also be continuing to develop their phonic knowledge in their daily Little Wandle Phonic sessions as well as their regular LW reading groups. In Maths, we will be exploring place value within 50 as well as learning about measuring length, height, mass and volume. In Science, they will be learning about Weather and Seasons. In Geography, we will be building on their understanding of their home town of Maidenhead and broadening their learning to include the United Kingdom with cross curricular links to their PSHE lessons Living in the Wider World: Diverse Britain. In P.E lessons, in their indoor sessions they will be developing rolling skills, and in outdoor sessions they will working on techniques and skills they will use during Sports Day. For their Design Technology project this term, they will be investigating, designing and making miniature playground equipment (suitable for a tiny toy). In Music, the theme is Dinosaurs and the focus will be on the musical concept of Dynamics. In R.E the children will learn about Palm Sunday. In Computing sessions, they will be focusing on algorithms and programming.
