Key Vocabulary	
aerial photos	a photo that is taken from above.
atlas	a book of maps (including maps of the world and continents).
globe	a 3D map of the world.
human features	things which are manmade in the environment, eg: bridges, buildings or roads.
map	a drawing of an area from above.
physical features	things which are naturally in the environment and haven't been made by people, eg: rivers, beaches or woodland.
symbols	pictures on maps which show different places, eg: roads, railways or post boxes.

- Describe what a human or physical feature is and name 3 of each feature.
- Discuss my local area including what it looks like on a map and human/physical features.
- Be able to compare different types of maps, such as globes, maps, aerial photos and atlases.
- Identify and name different symbols that appear on maps.
