Key Vocabulary

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| aerial photos | a photo that is taken from above. |
| atlas | a book of maps (including maps of the world and continents). |
| globe | a 3D map of the world. |
| human features | things which are manmade in the environment, eg: bridges, buildings or roads. |
| map | a drawing of an area from above. |
| physical features | things which are naturally in the environment and haven't been made by people, eg: rivers, beaches or woodland. |
| symbols | pictures on maps which show different places, eg: roads, railways or post boxes. |

- Discuss my local area including what it looks like on a map and human/physical features.
- Be able to compare different types of maps, such as globes, maps, aerial photos and atlases.
