**Locational Knowledge Skills:**  
 To name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

**Place Knowledge Skills:**  
 To be able to locate the Equator and the North and South poles.

**Human and Physical Feature Knowledge Skills:**  
 To identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

To use geographical vocabulary to refer to and describe weather and seasonal conditions.

**Map, Atlas, Globe, Compass and Gridwork, Fieldwork Skills:**  
 To use world maps, atlases and globes to identify all the continents and oceans.



## Key Vocabulary

<i>compare contrast</i>	Looking for similarities and differences between countries.
<i>continent</i>	A large mass of land which can be made up from individual countries. There are 7 continents: North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia and Antarctica.
<i>country</i>	A smaller piece of land which is within a continent, e.g. England or Spain.
<i>currency</i>	The money used in a country.
<i>Equator</i>	A line that goes around the centre of the Earth.
<i>globe</i>	A map which is a sphere and is a replica of the world.
<i>temperature</i>	How hot or cold a place is.
