



Continent	A continuous expanse of land.
Hemisphere	Half of the Earth, divided into the north and south by the equator.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth, exactly halfway between the north and south pole.
Capital City	The city from where the government functions. It is often the largest city in the country.
Latitude	Imaginary horizontal lines, showing how far north or south of the equator a place is.
Longitude	Imaginary vertical lines, showing how far east or west of the Greenwich Meridian a place is.
