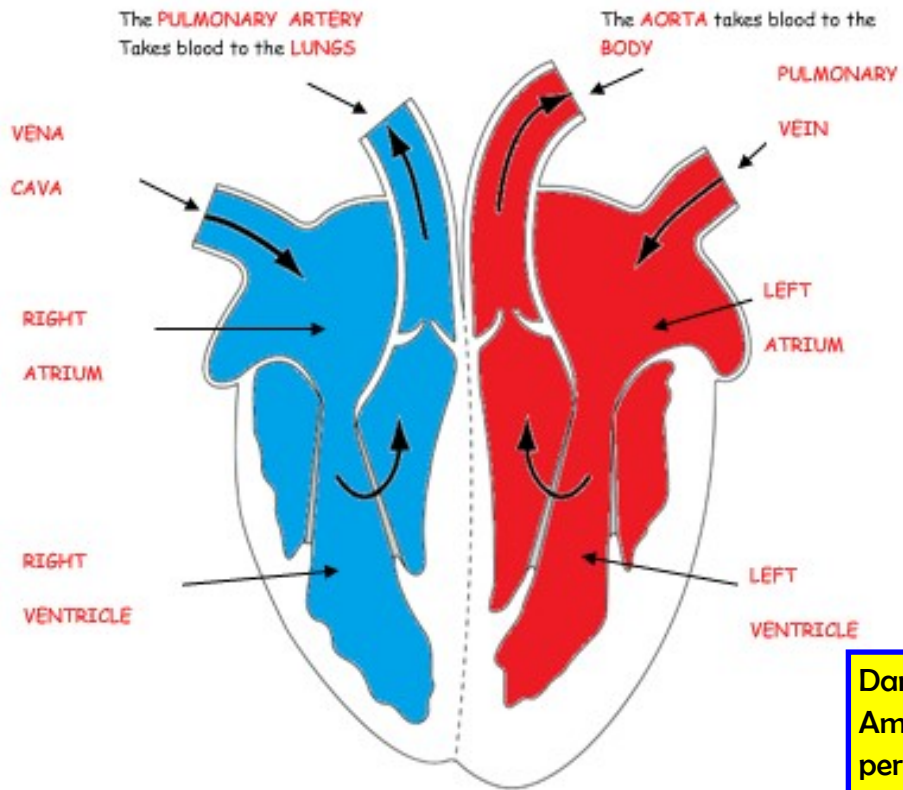


Key Vocabulary

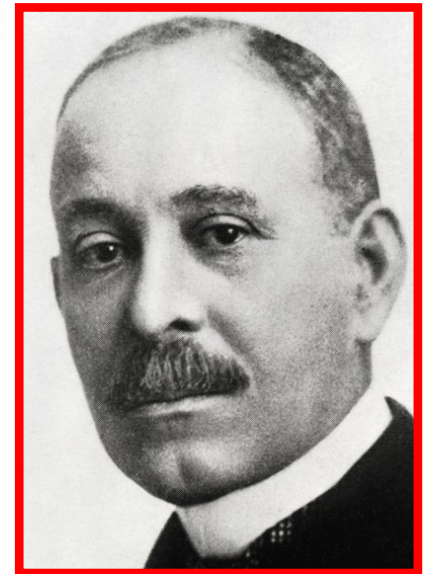

| Arteries | Carry oxygen inside blood vessels to muscles. |
| Circulation | The movement of blood and oxygen around the body. |
| Pulse rate | The speed at which a heart beats. |
| Drug | A substance which has a physical effect on the body. |
| Diet | The mixture and types of food are eaten. |
