11th October 1872: Emily Davison was born.
1906: Emily Davison began fighting for Women's rights.
4th June 1913: Emily Davison died after running in front of the King's horse at the Epsom Derby.

Rosa Parks

4th February 1913: Rosa Parks was born.
1st December 1955: Rosa Parks refused to give up her seat on the bus.
5th December 1955 - 20th December 1956: Bus boycott. For 381 days, 40,000 people didn't use buses in Rosa's hometown.
24th October 2005: Rosa Parks died.

Key Vocabulary

boycott	To stop doing something as a protest
suffragettes	Women who protested for the right to vote
segregation	Different groups kept separate from each other using physical dividers, eg: skin colour
rights	The ability to do something, e.g. the right to vote or human rights
