Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, we would like to wish you all a Happy New Year and, if we did not get the chance to say it to you personally at the end of term, a very grateful thank you to all those who sent in or contributed to such lovely gifts!

We hope your child is looking forward to the Reading Museum trip as much as we are. As a reminder, the trip is scheduled to take place on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> January; we require the children to arrive at the usual time and we will return to school at approximately 3:30pm. Also, you are all warmly invited to attend the Year 4 assembly on the 29<sup>th</sup> January.
