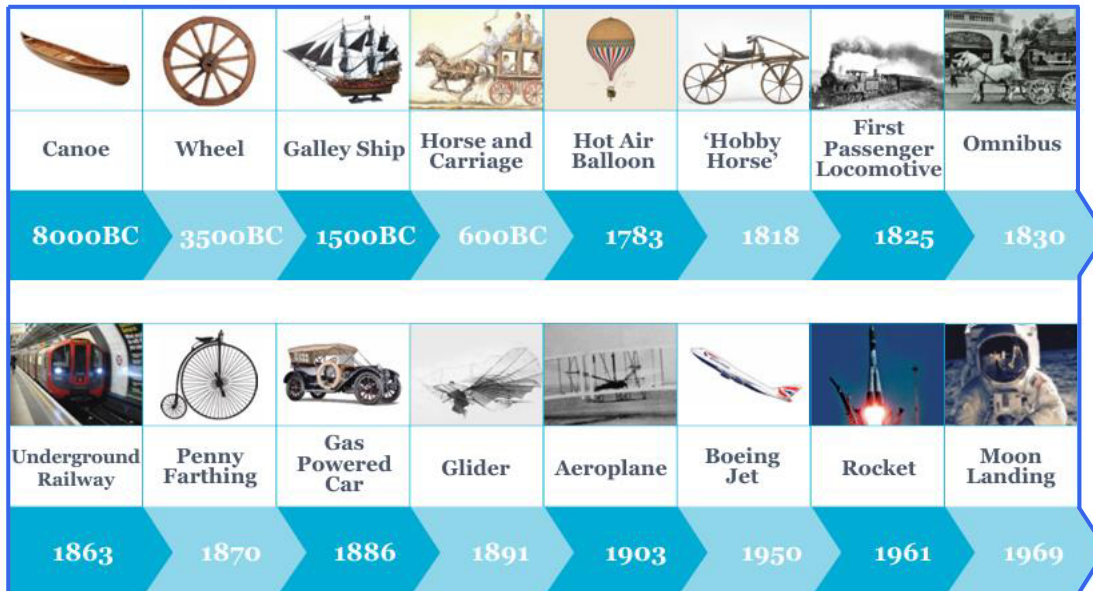


Knowledge and Skills:

Key Vocabulary:

engine		Machines that use energy (e.g. heat from coal or electricity) to make movement.
engineer		A person who uses science and maths to design and build <i>engines</i> and machines.
transport		How we travel from one place to another, such as by car, bus, train or bike.
petrol		The fuel used in some <i>engines</i> to make a vehicle move.
vehicle		Something that moves people or things from one place to another.
