



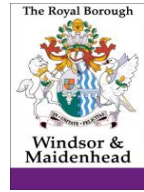

As shared in the previous swimming letter, your child will need a swimming costume (one-piece for females), a swimming cap, a towel and goggles.



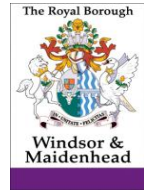

The children will be changing in school-only changing rooms, away from the general public. There are separate changing rooms for boys and girls. A member of staff will be situated in each changing room to ensure the children get changed in a timely manner. Staff will not help children with drying or getting dressed. The children must do this independently. We can help with swim hats and goggles.

Watches and earrings – whilst these are permitted as part of our school policy, we ask that children do not wear them as they will not be allowed to wear them during the swimming lesson.

Snacks – please send a healthy snack with your child. We will give the children a break and an opportunity to eat their snack once we return to school.

We have created social stories for each class which have been shared with them. Please find them linked to this email so you can read it again with them if they are feeling worried.

Parent/Carer Volunteers – a huge thank you to everyone who has been generous with their time and who have volunteered to walk with us. You're stars! We look forward to seeing you on Friday mornings. Just sign-in at the school office and we will join you as we walk past!

## Chiltern Open Air Museum – Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> April

As shared in the previous letter, every child will need to bring in a disposable packed lunch for the trip. The museum has designated areas to refill water bottles with drinking water, so children can bring their named water bottle with them.

As we are outside for most of the day, please could your child wear their outdoor PE kit and wear trainers. Legs will need to be covered (so warm leggings or jogging bottoms) due to the nature of the site.

We have looked at the weather (and this could easily change), whilst it looks to be dry, it will be a cloudy day with high temps of 13°C. Please could every child have a coat with them to ensure they stay warm.
