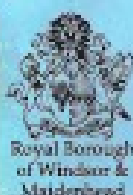

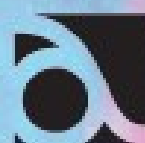

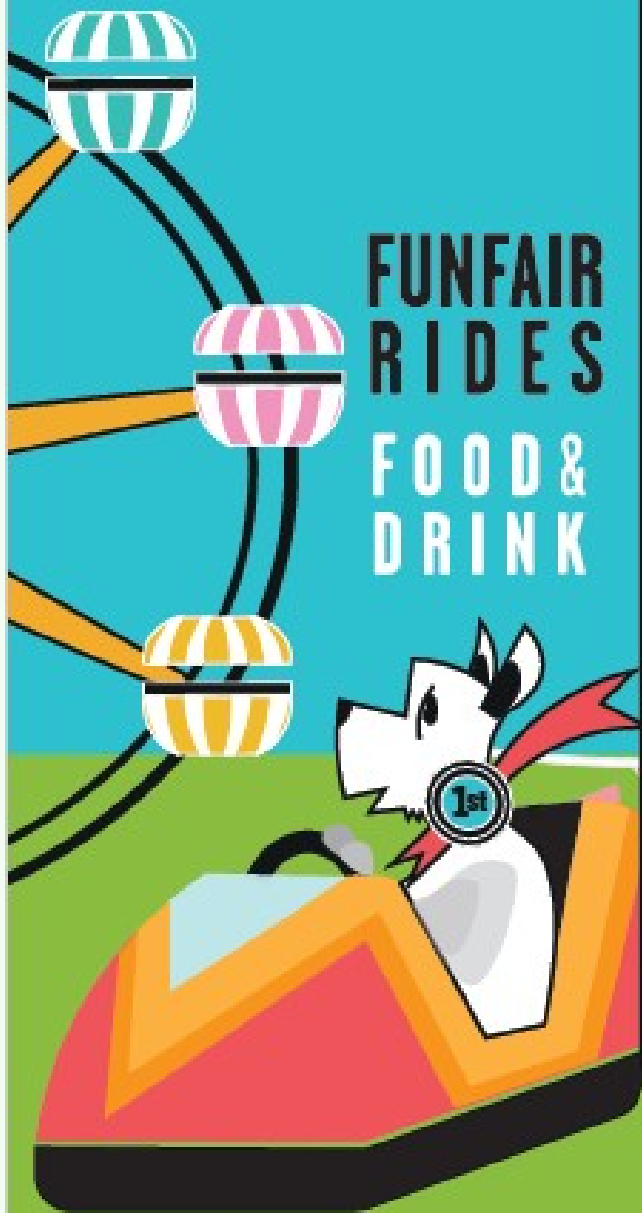

Scooter Squad

We are excited to launch our new **Scooter Squad** campaign, encouraging children to enjoy travelling to and from school on their scooters—**safely, confidently, and responsibly**.

Scooting is a fun and healthy way to get around, but it's important that everyone follows safe practices to keep themselves and others protected. With this in mind, we are asking all members of our school community to support the following key safety messages:



Scooter Squad Safety Rules

Always Wear a Helmet

Wearing a helmet is the most effective way to prevent head injuries. Please ensure helmets fit correctly, are securely fastened, and are worn every time a scooter is used.

Be Aware of Other Pedestrians

Paths can be busy during school travel times. Scooters should be ridden at a sensible speed, keeping to the left, slowing down near others, and never weaving between pedestrians.

Do Not Scoot Across Roads

Scooting across the road is dangerous. Children should **stop, dismount, and walk** their scooter when crossing any road or driveway.

Use the Green Cross Code

Students should follow the full Green Cross Code when crossing:

Think – Find a safe place to cross

Stop – Behind the kerb

Look & Listen – All around

Together We Can Make Scooting Safer

By following these simple safety steps, our children can enjoy all the benefits of scooting while keeping themselves and others safe. We encourage families to discuss these rules together and help reinforce them on the journey to and from school.
