Asia	The continent that China is in.
Population	The number of people that live in one place.
Climate	The type of weather conditions normally experienced in one area.
Currency	The type of money that is used in a country. Yen is the currency in China.
Human Features	These are buildings or structures that are man-made.
Physical Features	These are elements of the landscape that are naturally occurring like rivers, mountains, seas, deserts, cliffs and valleys.
