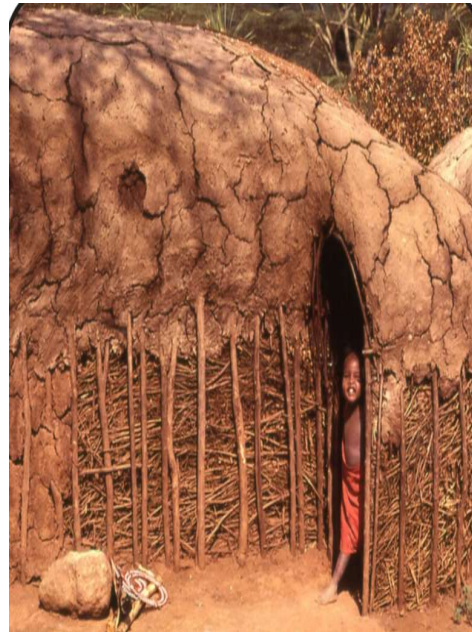


Key Vocabulary

Climate	The long-term weather in a specific place.
Continent	A large, solid area of land. We have previously learnt about the world's seven continents.
Country	An area or land controlled by its own government.
Human Features	Things around us that have been built by people. For example: houses, roads and bridges.
Physical Features	Things around us that would be here even if there were no people. For example: seas, mountains and rivers.
Tourist	People who travel the world to explore and have fun.
