To Parents/Carers of Children in Year 2 Elephant and Rhino

We are looking forward to getting to know the children in Year 2, and we hope that they are excited to be back in school as we are so happy to be starting the new year with them.

Both classes will cover the same learning objectives across the course of each week and will often work in collaboration with one another for whole year projects. The topics for termly study and home learning activities will also have the same learning objectives. In English the focus text is Follow the Swallow by Julia Donaldson and the writing will concentrate on the skills recounting the story and creating fact files. In Maths, they will develop their understanding of place value. In Science, they will be investigating and exploring materials and their properties. For the History topic, they will be learning about The Victorians. Foundation in rotation subjects will include PE, PHSE, RE and art and will take place on Monday and Tuesday. Computing will be on Thursdays.

Reading

The pattern of the reading system in Year 2, mirrors the one the children had in Year 1, with children bringing home a new reading book on Monday, and returning it each Friday. Their current book, reading record and supporting phonics documents should be kept in their reading folder and brought to school every day for opportunities to read with adults in school. Please continue to read and re-read their given text at least three times a week so that they can develop their decoding, prosody and fluency skills across the course of the week. Thank you for your support with this.

They will continue to work through the Little Wandle scheme this term, revisiting all Phase 5 sounds to support their confidence decoding phonics and developing fluency. They will revise all the covered phonemes and alternative sounds. Each week target sounds and linked spellings will be sent home to help support their confidence with their phonics.

P.E

This term, for both classes, indoor P.E. will be on Tuesday and outdoor P.E will be on a Thursday. Children should have the **correct standard PE kit** with **sweatshirts** and **navy joggers** for when the weather becomes colder. Please can you ensure that all items of P.E kit are **clearly named**, including trainers and plimsolls.

Home Learning

Set tasks will be stored in an individual folder for each child. Home Learning will be sent home each week on a Friday. Please continue to use Numbots to support children with their maths skills to earn your certificates in Celebration Assemblies! Please return the homework completed on the following Wednesday.
