Spring 1			The True Story Of The Three Little Pigs by Jon Scieszka 1996 In this hysterical and clever fracture fairy tale picture book that twists point of view and perspective, young readers will finally hear the other side of the story of "The Three Little Pigs."
Spring 2			Inspirational People (Mary Anning 1799 – 1847) 2020 Mary Anning was an English fossil collector, dealer, and palaeontologist.
